



Wrestling Mat Checklist

Important factors to consider when purchasing a wrestling mat

ASTM F1081 Standards

Meets or Exceeds ASTM F 1081-03

“Standard Specification for Competition Wrestling Mats”
in accordance with **ASTM F 355** *“Test Method for Shock Absorbing Properties”*. Must average less than (<) 100 G-max

Foam Core

Uses Rubber Nitrile Foam

The foam core is the most important element of a high-quality wrestling mat. Lower quality PVC foam and cross-linked polyethylene foam may not offer the same longevity, impact protection, or may not meet ASTM wrestling mat standards.

Vinyl Surface

Coated on all surfaces - including sides and edges

The vinyl surface applied to a wrestling mat is important in maintaining the integrity of the foam, added durability and helps in keeping the mat clean and properly disinfected. Exposed foam areas are difficult to clean.

Durability

Two-sided to provide wrestling areas on both sides

A well-designed wrestling mat should allow the user the ability to use both sides of the mat. This allows the mat to “wear” more evenly and extends the life of the mat foam and surface. The average life of a wrestling mat should be 15 years or more with proper care and maintenance.

Antimicrobial Protection

Built-in Microban® antimicrobial product protection

Microban technology is not something that is sprayed-on after the mat is manufactured. Microban protection is added directly during the manufacturing process to give the wrestling mat that added level of protection against microbes such as bacteria, mold and mildew that cause stains and odors. Microban protection is not a disinfectant and is not designed to protect users from disease-causing microorganisms.

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Design Options

26 color choices and customized layouts

Wrestling mats don't always have to come in 3-sections. You should have the ability to customize your mat to meet your specific requirements. One-piece, 3-sections, 5-sections - your manufacturer should offer layout choices at no extra charge.

Repairs & Reconditioning

Custom repair kits & Care and Handling Instructions

Ensure the longevity of your mat by fixing minor cuts and gouges when they occur. Over time, even with normal use and a good maintenance plan, you may want to have your mat reconditioned. This extends the useful life of the mat as much as 5 - 10 years and provides you with an extended 1-year warranty.

Life Cycle Cost

The lowest cost over the life of the mat

You should consider the Life-Cycle Cost of your mat when looking at different manufacturers. More mat sections mean more tape and can add hundreds or thousands to your mat costs over the life of the mat. Proper care and maintenance should allow your mat to last 15 or more years - translating to the lowest Life-Cycle Cost.

Cleaning & Disinfecting

The easiest to clean and disinfect

A wrestling mat should allow easy cleaning to all surfaces and edges. Exposed foam edges can be a breeding ground for microbes to hide. Proper cleaning practices should be followed on a regular basis using a manufacture-approved surface disinfectant so that you do not prevent the ability of your mat to be reconditioned in the future.
